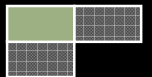

## 1 Introduction

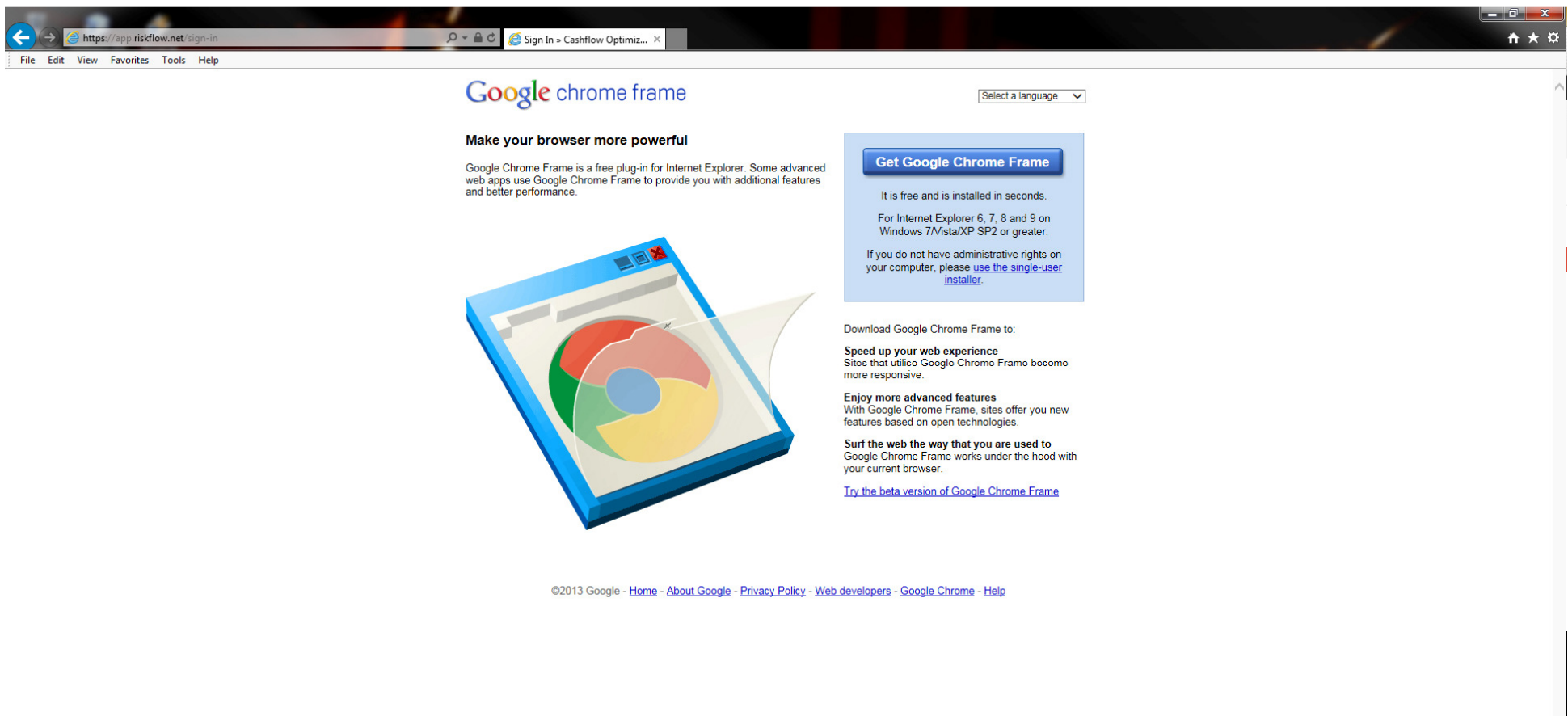
The Riskflow application's complexity creates various issues on the Internet Explorer browser. To solve this issue we implemented Google Chrome Frame. With Chrome Frame installed the Internet Explorer browser will render the page as if it was open in the Google Chrome browser without installing Google Chrome itself.

### 1.1 Getting Started with Chrome Frame

When the Riskflow Application URL is opened in Internet Explorer 7, 8 or 9 the user will be automatically directed to install Chrome Frame:

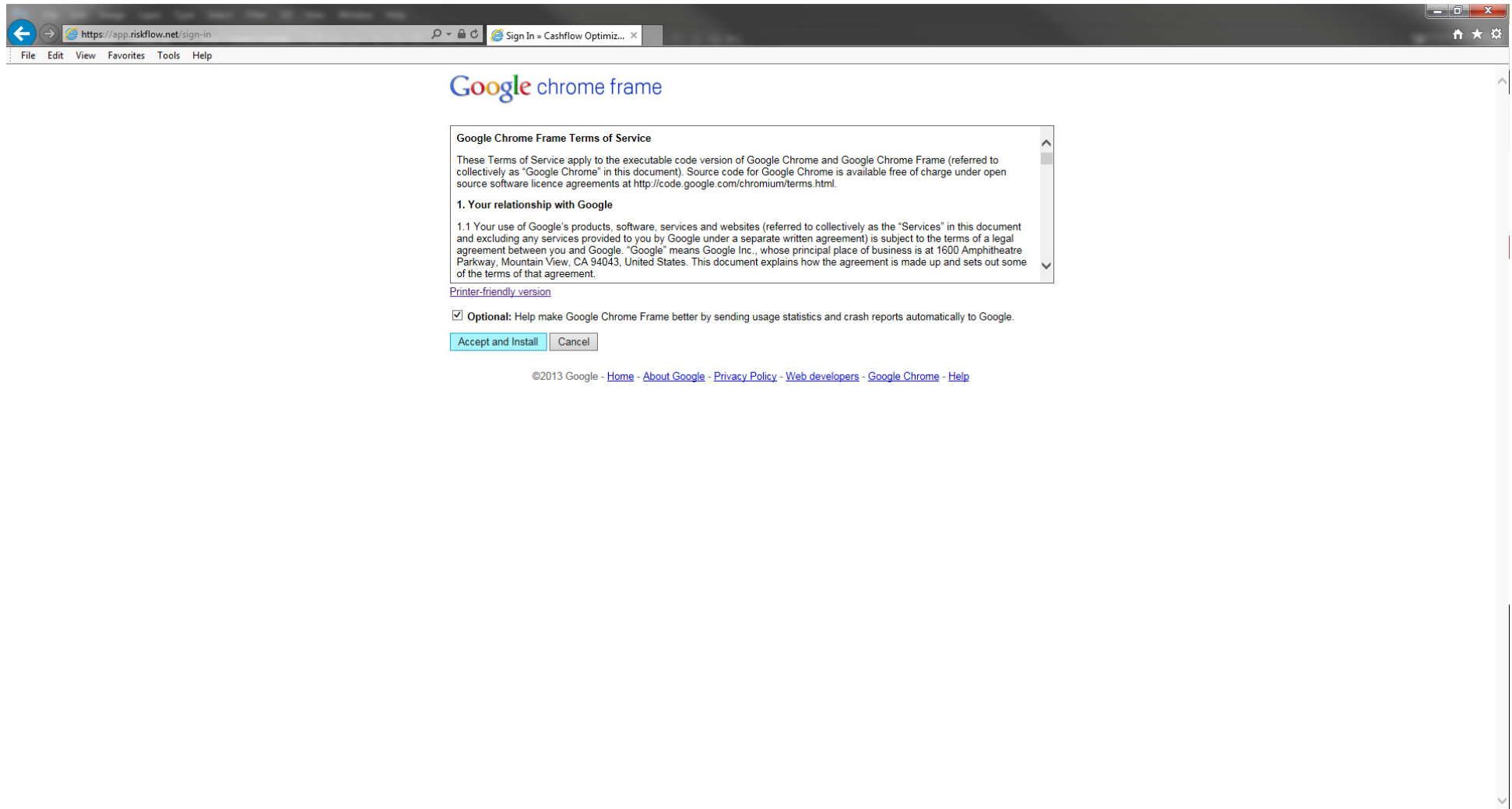
#### 1.1.1 Step 1

Click on the “Get Google Chrome Frame” button to start the installation.



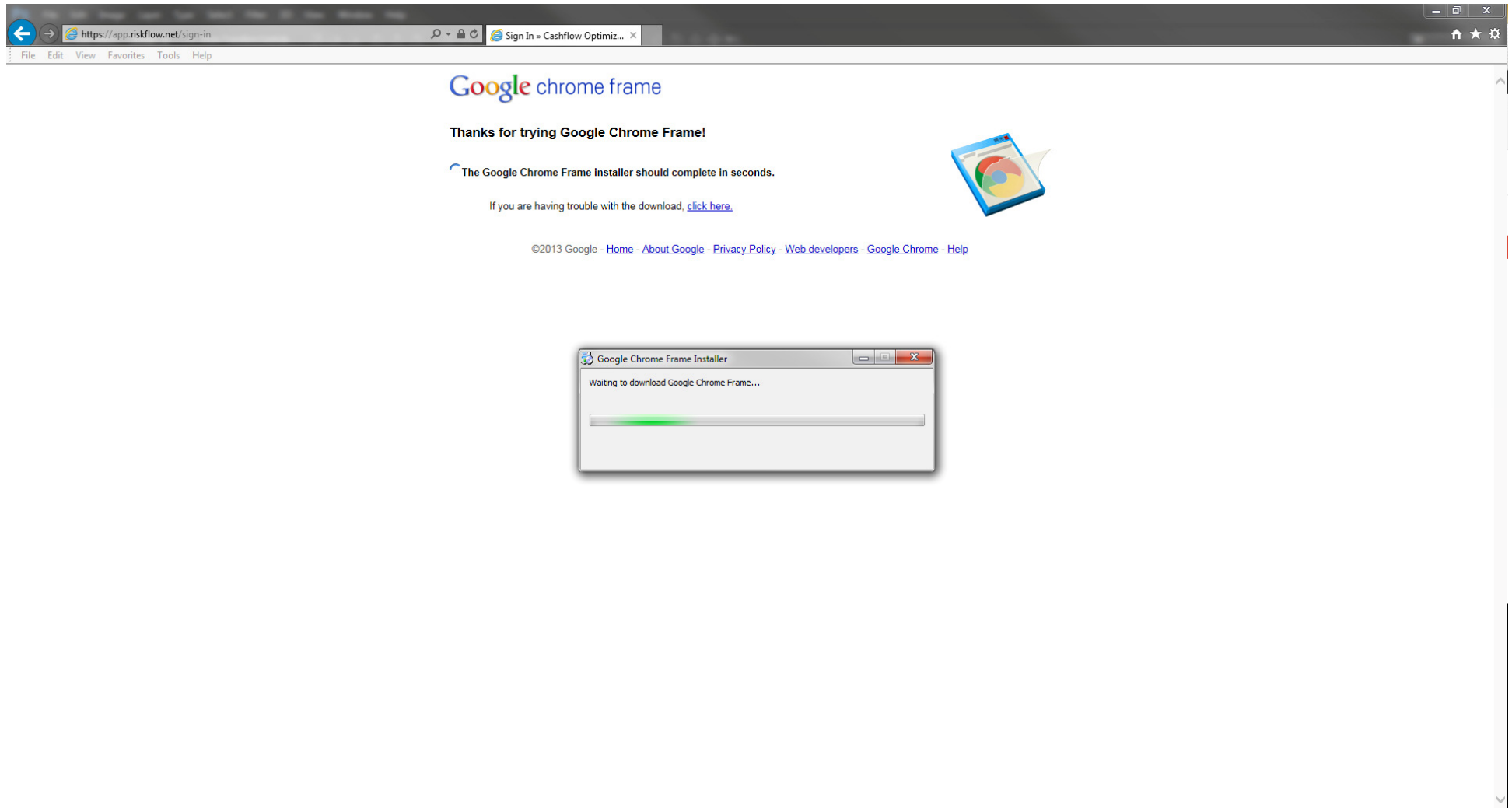
## 1.1.2 Step 2

You will be directed to the “Google Chrome Frame Terms of Service” page. You can as a ‘OPTIONAL’ selection to help improve Chrome Frame or just click the “Accept and Install” option to continue the installation.



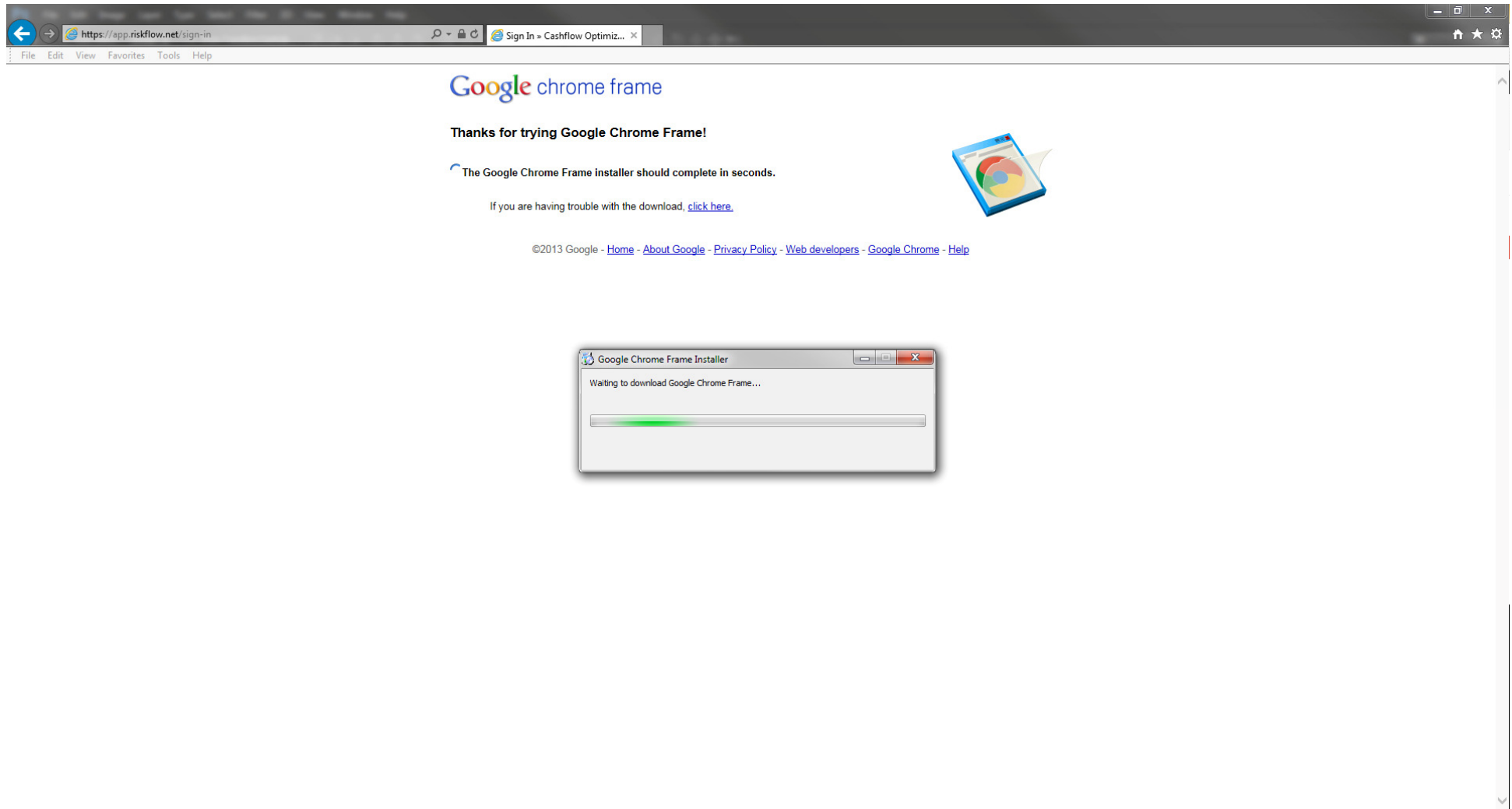
## 1.1.3 Step 3

The download will start automatically; just wait for the download to complete.



## 1.1.4 Step 4

Once Chrome Frame has been downloaded it will start installing Chrome Frame on your computer:
